STOP! I have a learning disability

Umbrella has been sent information from Healthwatch about the "STOP! I have a learning disability campaign" that as parents and carers you may be interested in. Patient



Health and Social Care watchdog Healthwatch Derbyshire has teamed up with the County's Good Health Group to better support individuals with learning disabilities.

Healthwatch Derbyshire and the Good Health Group - part of Derbyshire County's Learning Disability Partnership Board - have developed a poster entitled – STOP – I have a learning disability. It will be distributed to people with learning disabilities to take to appointments and displayed in GPs, dentists and hospitals across the County. The poster includes prompts for practitioners and patients to agree non-verbal signals if they are in pain, want to ask a question or need further support at the beginning of treatment or a consultation. The poster production followed a recent Healthwatch Derbyshire report detailing the views and experiences of people with learning disabilities and their carers when accessing health services. They found a particular issue highlighted was the need for better communication and understanding when patients need a procedure, such as dental treatment, to stop.

His confidence has grown and he happily tries all activities such as, bowling, climbing, roller skating and playing pool. Tom won the 14+ Ben Butler Award for his increased

independence this year.





Recently he conquered a huge milestone which Karis and his Mum are very proud of, when out for a carvery Tom tried a vegetable for the first time (probably just to get Karis to stop pestering him). The cauliflower cheese wasn't as bad as he imagined but we don't think he will be trying it again any time soon. As Tom is turning 18 this month his time with his 1:1 worker on Children's Services has come to an end. Karis is extremely proud of the independently confident young man he has become.
