


Where can I find support for myself?

December Highlights!





The Disabled children's Partnership have had a brilliant response to the two surveys they have run on the impact of the pandemic on disabled children and their families. They thank you again to everyone who has taken part and are extremely grateful.

They are planning further research in the new year. To support this, they are asking **parent carers with disabled children under 25 in England** to join an exclusive panel and take part in three to five short surveys between January and April 2021. Being a panel member will give you a stronger voice with government and help the Disabled Children's Partnership influence the levels of support for disabled children in the future.
